

The Holy Day Scheme, Revealing God's Plan for Mankind

The Weekly Sabbath: a weekly reminder of the seventh 1,000 year millennial rest in God's 7,000 year plan; no laborious work, a joy, etc. Ex. 20:8-11; Lev. 23:3.

The Land Sabbath: a seven-year reminder of the 7,000 year plan; no debt, no working of the soil, no pruning, eat what grows of itself; Lev. 25.

The Jubilee Year: a 50-year reminder of the 7,000 year plan; land never boughten or sold, removal of debt and slavery.

Passover

Christ's blood (the lamb's blood at the door) guarding our tabernacles from death (the death angel): for Israel only, not yet the Gentiles

Days of Unleavened Bread

Beginning of the barley harvest
Barley=Israelites in the ecclesia, as the firstfruits with God's Spirit
God's Spirit poured out only to Israelites, and to the righteous line from Seth -> Noah -> Abraham
Wave Sheaf=Israel

Pentecost

Beginning of the wheat harvest
Wheat=Gentiles in the ecclesia, as firstfruits with God's Spirit
God's Spirit poured out on all men of all tribes and tongues, including Israel: Joel 2:28
Two loaves= Israel + Gentiles
Christ has other sheep; one fold and one shepherd: John 10:16
Note the wheat vs. the tares: Matt. 13:24-30, 37-43

Feast of Trumpets

The Trumpet Plagues (Rev. 8, 9, and 11:14-19, with the resurrection at the seventh trumpet the focus, of both Israelite and Gentiles: Rev.7:1 -> 144,000 of Israel and the great multitude of Gentiles
Occurs at an uncertain time, the only such day amongst all of the Holy Days: we do not know the day or the hour of Christ's return: Matt. 24:36, 43-44; I Thess. 4:16-18; I Cor. 15: 50-52

Day of Atonement

The marriage supper in heaven
The high priest wore a linen garment when going into the Holy of Holies ->God's very presence in the heavenly Temple=>the saints at the marriage supper: Rev. 19:6-9
A fast, which purifies one's body, mind, and spirit so one can become like the Father and Christ, and stand in their presence: Isa. 58:6-12

Feast of Tabernacles

The millennial reign of Christ and the saints on earth: Rev. 20:6-8
Booths are a picture of the Kingdom nature: fruits (food) and beautiful foliage in abundance: Lev. 23:40; Deut. 16:14-15
A very active, joyous, and "dancing" time: see "solemn" in Deut. 16:15
A time of great abundance: Deut. 16:15; Acts 3:19-21; Isa. 11; 35:1-7
Living in booths since coming out of Egypt and Babylon=>sin, into a world without Satan's deceptions: Lev. 23:42-43

Last Great Day

The White Throne Judgement: Rev. 20: 11-15

Old Testament Church

The Line of Adam ->Shem->Jacob (Levitical Priesthood) (I Kings 19:18; Rom. 11:3-5)

New Testament Church

All peoples and nations (Melchisedec Priesthood) (Rom. 11:3-5; Acts 2,3)

A Melchisedec Priesthood throughout this time

Christ, the Holy Angels, and Saints wage war against the Beast and false Prophet: Rev. 19:11-21

Satan and the demons are bound for 1,000 years: Rev. 20:1-3

Satan is released for a little while, and then destroyed: Rev. 20:7-10

The Crucifixion and Resurrection

The removal of sins for those called and chosen, past and future: Jer. 31:31-34; Heb. 8:7; etc.; not just a covering of sins pictured by the blood sacrifices of innocent animals: Lev. 17:11; Heb. 9:22, 24-28; 9:11-14; 10:11-20

Levitical laws were only a picture of what the true plan of God is: see Heb. 9:23; 10:1
