The Holy Day Scheme, Revealing God's Plan for Mankind

The Weekly Sabbath: a weekly reminder of the seventh 1,000 year millennial rest in God's 7,000 year plan; no laborious work, a joy, etc. Ex. 20:8-11; Lev. 23:3. The Land Sabbath: a seven-year reminder of the 7,000 year plan; no debt, no working of the soil, no pruning, eat what grows of itself; Lev. 25. The Jubilee Year: a 50-year reminder of the 7,000 year plan; land never boughten or sold, removal of debt and slavery.
