
The Feast of Trumpets ... a Review of Its Message for Us Today

Time Line of Feast Day Fulfillment



- The spring Feast days in Nisan (month 1)
- Christ's first coming
- Physical Israel was redeemed
- God blew the shofar at Mt. Sinai to prepare His nation Israel for the "Old Covenant" (Exodus 19; 18-20).

What the Feast of Trumpets signifies

1. It signals the assembly of God's elect to the Father (Matthew 24:31).

2. It sounds the alarm for God's battle against Satan and this wicked world as he begins the "great day of His wrath" (Revelation 6:17).

3. It announces the coming of the Messiah, who alone will be "exalted in that day" (Isaiah 2:17).

Good News!!!

The righteous, in general, will be delivered from the wrath to come (I Thessalonians 1:10), since God has not appointed them unto wrath. However, some will suffer and be killed for the sake of Christ (Luke 21:12-19).

- The fall Feast days in Tishri (month 7)
- Christ's second coming
- Spiritual Israel will be redeemed.
- God will blow the shofar when He returns to prepare His people for the "New Covenant" (those who are not firstfruits: Zechariah 9:14; 14:3-9).
- The Day of the Lord will arrive, a time of darkness and travail ("Days of Awe").
- God's wrath will be poured out on all the earth, bringing repentance to Israel and all nations. Amos 5:18-20 Zephaniah 1:14-16 Joel 2:31; 3:15 Isaiah 13:9-10; 34:4-8 Acts 2:20 Revelation 6:12-17 Matthew 24:1-51
- Christ will likely return on the Feast of Trumpets, also the time of the first resurrection. I Corinthians 15:45-58 I Thessalonians 4:13-18
- The actual resurrection will occur, with the saints ascending to the heavenly throne of God. Matthew 24:31 Revelation 11.15; 19:7-9
- Babylon the Great will be destroyed, the present economic-religious-political system of this world Revelation 16:16-21: 17(all); 18(all); 19: 19:11-21
